

NSS ANNUAL REPORT 2018-19

The official inauguration of National Service Scheme for the academic year 2018-19 was done by the Principal Dr K C Mathai. Extension activities general coordinator Dr R Harichandran gave the guidance for the further progress of the unit, even though the unit continued its activities from the previous year. The first programme of the year started with planting trees in relation to Environment day on 06.06.2018. The weekly meetings were continued on every Tuesday evening. Ms. Mekha Salim attended PFMS training at IHRD, Chengannur on 11.06.2018.

In association with 'Swanthvanam Trust' as part of world blood donors day a seminar and blood grouping session was conducted in college seminar hall on 14. 06. 2018.

PFMS training programme at Kerala University for PO was attended by Ms. Mekha Salim on 19.06.2018 and participated in the Suchitwa Mission training for PO on 20.6 2018 at Gandhi Smaraka Seva Kendram, Alappuzha.

Volunteer Secretary Lince David attended the two day residential training on disaster management, first aid and basic skills organized by Kerala University in association with Kerala State Disaster management Authority on 21. 06. 2018.

Yoga day was celebrated with yoga practice on 21. 06. 2018. Principal Dr. K C Mathai presided over the meeting. The senior volunteers demonstrated yoga possess for the volunteers.

A general orientation about extension activities and aims and about NSS was given for the volunteers on 23.06.2018 in the college seminar hall. The programme was intended to give a momentum to the activities to be undertaken for the year. A group discussion was also arranged to voice ideas of volunteers.

On 14.07.2018 as per the guidance of the university jackfruit tree saplings were planted in the college campus.

Keerthi Sreekumar was sent to Kerala University for three day residential camp on Women Capacity building programme on 07.08.2018.

Volunteers participated in various disaster management and rescue activities on Kerala flood. Volunteers gathered and interacted with the campers in college and visited the flood stricken area near the college. The college was converted into a collection centre by NSS. Volunteers and students collected, contributed and packed essential commodities for flood affected campers on 22.08.2018. Thus with the support of NSS a survival kit was provided. In association with the Indian Railway volunteers participated in Swatch Vidhyalay and cleaned the allotted school at Chengannur on 28.08.2018. After gaining training at Bishop Moore College, Mavelikara on 17.09.2018, well water was tested in Thalavady on 08.09.2018.

Santo Sebastian was awarded the best volunteer award on 18.09.2018 at Kerala university.

A rally on NSS day celebration proclaiming its aims and objectives was held on 24.09.2018.

An Orientation camp by Dr. C Pradeep Kumar, PO of NSS College, Pandalam was conducted on 29.09.2018 in the college seminar hall. The meeting was presided by the Principal Dr. K C Mathai.

A cleaning drive was done on 2.10.2018 in the college campus in relation with Gandhi Jayanthi. Gandhi Quiz and drawing competition was also conducted.

Ms. Aswathy p participated in the PFMS training conducted at Kerala University on 5. 10. 2018. Joel Koshy Mathew and Surabhi K Suji attended the Pre RD selection camp at Trivandrum on 08.10.2018.
