Along with the poetry exhibition, “The Macbeth Cave” was creatively designed and an Inter – School – College poetry recitation was conducted on the day. Various programs were organized and attended by Arcadia students. Under the leadership of the association they attended two seminars initiated by Bishop Moore College, Kallumala and a debate competition organized by St. Aloysius College, Edathua on 17 February 2016. A Spelling Bee Competition was organized by the association on the 2 March 2016 in which twenty students took part. Students who held the first five positions were sent to Peet Memorial College for an intercollegiate Spelling Bee competition the next day in which our college bagged the third prize.
- The English Association – ‘De Fabula’ was inaugurated on the 21<sup>st</sup> of November 2016 with Prof. Renjith Krishnan, NSS College, Pandalam as the chief guest and keynote speaker. The events included live theater, quiz etc. Under the leadership of the association they attended two seminars initiated by Bishop Moore College, Kallumala and a paper presentation competition on 7<sup>th</sup> March 2017 and 16<sup>th</sup> March 2017.

- The English Association – ‘Merakhi’ was conducted on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of March 2018 with Prof. Harsha Vishwanath, MSM College, Kayamkulam as the chief guest and keynote speaker. The events included sand art, quiz, spot photography etc.
- ARCADIA fest was conducted on 19<sup>th</sup> February Inaugurated and talked on paradigm shift in literary theory by Dr. Divya, assistant professor English, bishop Moore college
- The department organised a webinar series. The series was inaugurated on 25<sup>th</sup> August, 2020 with a lecture by **Dr. V Krishnakumar**, Former HOD, MSM College, Kayamkulam. The second lecture of the series was given by **Mrs Nada Rajan**, Assistant Professor, MSM College, Kayamkulam. The final session of the series was handled by the famous short story writer **Mrs. Khyrunnisa A.** The Department organized an Intercollegiate Quiz competition in which students from different colleges across the world took.
