LIQUID WASTE MANAGEMENT

Liquid waste is generated from the hostel, washroom, and canteen.

Liquid wastes generated by the college are of two types:

- 1. Sewage waste.
- 2. Residential washing and canteen effluent.
- 3. Rain water.

The sewage wastes are kept aloof by building proper septic tanks which will prevent the contaminated sewage water from mixing with pure ground water, thereby the pollution water resources is checked.

Other liquid wastes are mainly drained to improve the ground level of water. Inorder to allow the natural flow of water as per the ecological dimension of the campus a proper drainage facility is provided. This helps in the free flow of rainwater and in maintaining a pedestrian friendly pathway.
