SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT

Pollution from waste is aesthetically unpleasing and results in large amounts of litter in our community which can cause health problems. Solid waste can be categorised into three types: biodegradable, non-biodegradable and hazardous waste. Biodegradable wastes include food wastes, canteen waste, wastes from toilets etc. Non-biodegradable wastes include plastic, tins and glass bottles etc. Hazardous waste is waste that is likely to be a threat to health or the environment like cleaning chemicals, acids and laboratory chemicals.


Each and every department of Mar Ivanios College of Arts and Science, Mavelikara as well as the administrative offices create some waste that is dumped in a small waste bin located in the department. In each building several dust bins are placed from where housekeeping staff take the wastes. From the small bins wastes are segregated and dumped in big bins by the housekeeping staff regularly. Biodegradable wastes are dumped into a pit made for this purpose inside the college campus.

College discourages the use of plastic; particularly single use plastics on the campus.

The college produces a lot of paper waste. They are disposed of through vendors. The wastes are properly stacked and later disposed through vendors for proper waste management. College promotes digital platform to reduce the usage of paper for communication and sharing documents.







Milking Machine
